



## **CAMPTON'S U17 NAVY BOYS TRAVEL TO NORTH CAROLINA FOR NATIONAL LEAGUE COMPETITION**

Campton walked away with one point in their first National League match in Wilson, North Carolina. The team played Oklahoma state champions Tulsa Red to a 2-2 finish.

The match finished 0-0 at half with goalkeeper Nate Esler keeping a clean sheet after a fantastic penalty stop in the 22nd minute. Campton took a second half lead at the 45:38 mark with a well orchestrated build up that lead to Chris Tomek firing in the first goal of the year from 18 yards. The team followed up with a second goal by Zach Matuszak 10 minutes later. Tulsa received a second weak penalty in the 59th minute, this time eluding Esler. After some back and forth play Kevin Hilgart scored a quality header in the 65th minute off a corner, the ball hitting the underside of the crossbar and bouncing down over the Tulsa line. Amazingly the assistant referee flagged the goal off, claiming it never crossed the line and play continued. In the 88th minute some sloppy midfield defending allowed Tulsa some room to penetrate up the middle and finish on some well combined movement. The match ended at 2-2.

Campton will face Elite FC Gladiators of New Mexico, ranked 9th in the nation, on Friday at noon.
