## **Campton United Soccer Club Player Training Safety Policy**

- **We have a designated drop-off and pickup location.**
- **Parents are not allowed drop-off, pickup, or park at the lot adjacent to the training area. This is done to protect the many players and coaches that are passing through that area and over the gravel road.**
- **When parents are dropping off players, please provide enough time for players to get to and from the designated training area assigned to each team. This allows coaches to properly start and optimize their training session.**
- **All U7 thru U8 teams will be picked up and dropped off from the designated area by their coaches.**
- **If a player is attending an extra training session, parents are to contact either the coach or Director of Coaching for that age group prior to the training session they are attending. This allows coaches to make sure they can adequately absorb additional players into their session and still provide a quality and safe training session for the team.**
- **Players are to go straight to their designated training field. When possible, players are encouraged to go as a group to training.**
- **Once training starts, coaches are to review player attendance.**
- **During training, coaches not only develop and evaluate player and teams but they also look for injury, sickness, and attendance.**
- **At the designated training area, multiple first aid kits are available.**
- **When training is beyond the designated location (i.e. jogging activity) players are tracked for injury, sickness, and attendance. When the activity is complete back at the designated training location, player attendance is checked again.**

**June 9, 2010**

- **At the conclusion of training, coaches are to review player attendance and observe players retrieving their belongings.**
- **Players are to go straight to their designated pickup location and when possible, as a group.**
- **Parents are asked to please arrive on time for picking up their children. This allows coaches to get back to another training session and reduces the child's stress level.**
- **Parents and players are to proceed with caution as they traverse through the parking lot in order to get to their vehicles.**
- **At the end of the days training sessions, once coaches release players, some coaches will walk with players back to designated pickup location, and other coaches will drive back to pickup location to observe player safety and account for all players have been picked up by their designated driver.**
- **When inclement weather (i.e. lightening) interrupts training, players will be brought back to the main office building (inside the office or garage area). Parents will either be contacted via their child's cell phone or by coaches. Under the picnic area at the office building is not suitable for lightening protection.**
